You will learn about the cycle of bloom (from pruning to bloom) and how you can achieve huge and healthy blooms by customizing your own fertilizing program. You will also learn about the benefits of organic and chemical fertilizing.

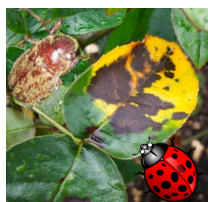


## PRUNING ROSES
